
COVID-19 Electrical Manufacturer Plant Closings

As of: 4/24/2020

- **Bridgeport** - Production has been Temporarily shut down. They built up inventory beforehand to serve the customers. The warehouse remains open for shipping.
- **Cooper Lighting** -- Two plants in MX. Mexicali South of California is temp closed due to Government regulators. Working on getting it established as essential. Potential product impacts will be HALO & Emergency & Exit if closure extends, but DC stock is good for now. Bigger concerns would be for large factory direct shipment projects. DC's in: Chicago, Northern Cali, Peachtree, Georgia. Vicksburg Mis, Denver Co are up & running and have light assembly capabilities to cover practically all requirements.
- **Eaton Bussmann** – Juarez Plant (UL products like RK1, RK5, J, Class L, CC and Midget fuses) – May 4th is expected to be reopened – have inventory in the USA DC's
- **Eaton Gear** – Bus-plugs and transformers are not being shipped from Juarez plant. – May 4th is expected to be reopened – very limited inventory in chain.
- **Electri-flex** - Has and will continue to shut down Shipping on Fridays this has been in effect for the month of April
- **Hubbell Electrical** - Both Wiegmann and Raco will have 2 Furlough weeks 1 of them was already this week and another one to come they will have Production shut down but will be shipping orders.
- **Hubbell Lighting** – Columbia plant in Tijuana is likely going to shut down today (4/23). They are shipping all the manufactured material out to the US market now, but expect a closure letter soon.
- **Hubbell Power** -- We have abided by all governmental and local policies and to-date, have had no reported COVID-19 cases in our Juarez facilities. Even so, with authorities working to “flatten the curve” and slow the spread of COVID-19, in concert with the Mexican government, we have made the decision to suspend operations at our Juarez facilities. This includes our facility manufacturing overhead switching and connector products primarily for the distribution market and our facility manufacturing enclosure products primarily for the telecommunications market. We expect both

facilities to reopen sometime in early May and will provide more specific timing in the near future. While we have redundant operations that will help mitigate the impact to our customers, this closing will inevitably cause service delays. Serving our customer remains a primary concern and we are working diligently to overcome these unforeseen actions. We will be updating lead-times and customer promise dates, as impacted by the temporary suspensions. We are actively pursuing options to reduce service issues with stock from our distribution center and adjusting production, where we have redundant operations in our U.S. facilities.

- **Legrand EWS (P&S, Wiremold, Cablofil)** - 4/22 Mexico Tijuana site stopped production per gov action. EWS shares produces Wiremold, P&S and Cablofil in our Tijuana facility. P&S & Wiremold has manufacturing redundancy for these products and holds a significant inventory in DC. They do not currently anticipate a significant impact to our ability to service our distributor's needs. Specifically impacted P&S/Wiremold items could include non-stock or non-traditional colors, substitutes would be offered. Cablofil impacted items are FASPower- prefab custom wiring & Ladder
- **Mersen** – Most products - Juarez shut down due to positive test and limited labor. Looking to open first week in May – should have enough inventory in US DC's.
- **Signify / Philips** - Tijuana is currently shut down. Key product at this facility is EVO kits. Projection will re-open sometime in May. Impact to supply chain and other components is not known at this time. Also, Sanmina plant is closed which impacts some portion of our Color Kinetics products. All US operations are up and running. We have communicated to our agents all the projects that may be impacted by this.
- **Schneider Electric/ Square D** – Pacifico Plant closed for likely some time due to social distancing issues in production (residential breakers – list sent to authorized SQD OPCO's) – trying to get new manufacturing up in other NA location first week of May
